Centennial Airport Hosts Noise Compatibility Planning Open House

ENGLEWOOD, CO –The Arapahoe County Public Airport Authority, as owner and operator of Centennial Airport, will be updating the airport's **Noise Exposure Map (NEM)** and extends an invitation to the public to attend an informational open house. The update is part of the airport's noise mitigation program.

What: Centennial Airport NEM Update Public Open House

The update involves an information-gathering exercise that will identify and inventory various aircraft operations and determine and evaluate noise exposure levels related to land use compatibility at Centennial Airport. Completion of the NEM Update is expected by fall 2016 with a formal submittal to the FAA for acceptance.

The NEM is a work element of the Centennial Airport Part 150 Noise Compatibility Program, which is a voluntary Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) program that recommends guidelines for airport noise compatibility planning. The NEMs establish a current baseline and a five-year forecast of aircraft noise exposure levels based on existing and future traffic respectively.

"Centennial Airport is committed to airport noise compatibility planning and working closely with the surrounding communities," said Michael Fronapfel, director of planning and development for Centennial Airport. "Given it has been more than five years since the Centennial Airport noise exposure map has been updated, and our new noise monitoring system collects aircraft operations and noise data, now is the right time to initiate this important project."
