CACNR met on August 4, 2021, after having to cancel its scheduled July 7, 2021 meeting.

Four members of the public spoke, with a variety of similar complaints about increased and repetitive aircraft noise over their homes. Many of the complaints were perceived to involve those originating from flight schools. CACNR's planned meeting with the flight schools was noted, as were some of the limitations which exist when planes are out of the airport's airspace, and the reliance on pilots to fly quiet solely on a voluntary basis.

One planning meeting had been held between CACNR and its consultant, airport staff, and representatives from Arapahoe and Douglas Counties, to establish an agenda for the meeting with the flight schools. It is anticipated that meeting will be held in September.

Updates to the CACNR website are ongoing.

Whispertrack information for Centennial Airport has been updated and is accessible by all Whispertrack users throughout the nation.

Plans were made to hold an educational session for CACNR in October, with a focus on the design, capabilities, and usage of the noise monitor system and its available data. A review of information desired from the system will be conducted, and any thoughts/requests from ACPAA members would be welcomed as well.

A brief review of the recent accidents at Centennial Airport was received, as was an update on the judicial ruling on the airport's Metroplex lawsuit, and the anticipated response to that ruling.
