Workplan Committee:

- Continuing to work with Jason Schwartz regarding work plan priority to meet with the flight schools. New proposal was approved not to exceed \$3000. Jason will facilitate the meeting with the flight schools.

Outreach Committee:

- Updating FAQ's on the website.

Fly Quiet Committee:

- Have re-established talks with Whispertrack regarding adding the KAPA Noise Abatement Guidelines to their electronic tablet application. Met to review the current KAPA Whispertrack entries. Reviewed the updates with Rachel so that data can be added and updated as required.
- Discussing night time operations. Complaint from Aurora resident with excessive night flights. Rachel worked with the resident to investigate the complaint.

Noise Monitor Committee:

- Noise monitors on the website not listed by location. Request to list which monitor covers which area. Have the map, would prefer more detailed description.
- Complaints about helicopter noise over Centennial area late at night. If military, then may not be able to track it. Highland Ranch and Unincorporated Douglas County have also heard it.
- Douglas County's fire helicopter is now in Louviers for the season.

Work Program:
