RECOMMENDATION: Information Only

BACKGROUND: The Senate is expected to take up the \$1.9T corona virus relief bill, the third of its kind, ahead of the unemployment benefit package expiration, which was part of the 2nd round of virus relief funding. As previously reported, the package as proposed, also provides \$800B for airports, including \$100M for primary and GA airports. Centennial Airport is expected to get approximately \$57,000. There is currently no other business being discussed on Capitol Hill that would affect Centennial Airport.

The State Legislature is in session and while some 300+ bill have been introduced, only "forever chemical" bills could have an impact on how the airport moves forward with firefighting suppression systems in some of the hangars on the airport, as well as South Metro Fire and Rescue District testing and using AFFF, which contains such forever chemicals. It is too early to see where that is going at this time.
